Importance of livestock production

India is a tropical country and livestock production in India is characterized by many unique opportunities and challenges. The animal products produced in the form of milk, meat and egg is highly nutritious containing all the essential nutrients needed for sustenance and growth of life on earth. Without these key nutrients it is not possible to lead a healthy life. The modern science has also thrown lot of challenges to the subject due to the advancements made in the field of Breeding, Nutrition and Health. Though, we have produced one of the finest breed in the world by means of cross breeding and upgrading the livestock through thousands of years of breeding policy by the animal keeper for their increased demand for milk, meat and egg or draft or aesthetic values, farmers or animal keepers are experiencing lot of health issues due to production related matter. We know that production is a big strain on the animal, it compromises with the physiology of the animal, putting it to lot of strain and stress. This leads to heavy expenditure on health and related issues. Hence, ideal livestock management should be targeted with the aim of having lifetime production than lactation yield. We can always remember the famous photo of Mahatma Gandhi at NDRI Bangalore visit way back in June 1927, with a cow named Jill standing besides with a lifetime yield of 70,000 litres and eighteen number of calving. This cow was a Haryana cross with Ayrshire and lived for 19.5 years with an average daily yield of 14 liters per day.

Livestock production is also important from the point of human health. Increased consumption of grains in India is causing metabolic syndrome among the citizens, thereby lowering their life span. It is also causing them to be unproductive due to ill health due to hospitalisation and treatments days spent in visiting and getting treated at the hospital. Mentally people will suffer from increased cost of treatment and may have lowering of confidence. Since the grains are high in energy content and lower in protein content, its consumption leads to imbalanced intake of nutrients causing all the health related issues and ill health thereby is reducing the lifespan of an individual. The lifespan of the individual is most

needed when he has learnt the subject well, well experienced and to be of some use to the community. At the peak of his performance we are losing human resource due to less consumption of animal products.

Livestock production in India or in tropical country for that matter are characterized by unique features such as high amount of temperature and humidity due to direct rays of the sun falling on the ground in comparison to the inclined rays falling at temperate regions, high lignin content in the plants and forages due to their early maturity, low yield from the animals due to increased stress from the weather, increased parasitic load, sometimes local legislations such as ban on cattle slaughter may reduce the genetic progress due to no culling. Also it will reduce the availability of feed and fodder due to high density of animals in a given area, it will also reduce the grazing area, often leading to over grazing of pasture land. So, this triple reason of weather, culling policy and marketing all get interconnected leading to reduced output from the animals, increased disease burden of both humans and animals and lower development of the nation. This complex web or vicious cycle need to be broken from all angles including modifying the weather for temperature and humidity balanced feeding of animals in terms of forages and concentrates and increased consumption of animal products by humans for better livestock production and management. One more constraint in livestock production in India is that of lower consumption of animal products due to ignorance, economic reasons and culture of frugality by the masses. Many a times the cost of production of milk, meat and egg equals the cost of the product itself. So, in the absence of any margin or profits in the production process, it may discourage the producer to go for any advancement or increasing the strength of the stock. Livestock production in India is traditionally practiced as subsistence business without any commercial output from it. Most of the farming is done by the woman folks of the community, who have less access to the market and due to the culture of male dominance are poor decision makers. The overall

health and political system of a nation is also a contributing factor for the development of livestock sector in any country.

In spite of all the constraints enumerated above, there is a ray of hope due to the beneficial effects of animal products. As compared to fruits and vegetables consumption and their price in our country, animal products always stand a chance to improve its performance. In comparison to the nutrient content, its price, animal products are always superior to the plant products. It is many times due to religious reasons or welfare issues that plant products get promoted and the animal products get a bad name. The present generation of youth who are well read and travelled know the importance of animal products. It is these youths from various back ground and qualification are venturing into animal farming in commercial way. The country will see the consumption of animal products increasing in coming days with increase in affluence in the society. The dry matter (DM) content of food is a key element in knowing its nutritive value. Often the DM content of fruits and vegetables is as low as 5-10 per cent, whereas it is 15-25 per cent with animal. Also the protein and fat content is negligible or zero with fruits and vegetables, whereas its very high with animal products. The sugar content is very high with plant foods, whereas its negligible with animal foods. The high fibre and water content generally increases the bulk and cause fullness of stomach with plant foods without delivering quality nutrients whereas, there is no fibre available with animal foods and delivers the nutrients in appropriate quantity and quality with low water content in them. The vital amines such as

Vit B₁₂, Leucine, high protein and high fat with no sugar or carbohydrate contents etc make these products indispensable to human mankind. The more the affluent a country is the better is their animal products consumption and lower income countries have less of animal products consumption.

Apart from being a good source of food for human consumption, animal products are used in almost about 80 industries as raw material for production of goods such as, comb, brush, anti sera used in treatment of snake and scorpion bite, mineral mixture, blood meal used as raw material for production of feed in poultry, leather for shoes and all the leather items, dog feed, whey protein, dairy, poultry, food industry for production of milk and egg powder, ghee, paneer, cheese, and many items of consumption etc. No part of animal is wasted and it is recycled into the food production or other usages. Animals are used widely for draft power for tilling of land, pets are used as companion animals and help many psychological and depression issues in human beings and future use of animals will be towards sports and entertainment, police and army usage etc.

The scope of livestock production is very wide and includes all animals of food production such as Cattle, Buffaloes, Sheep, Goat, Rabbit, Poultry (which comprises of hen, duck, emu, quails, aesthetic birds etc) Yak, Camel, Pig, Donkey, Game animals such as Horse, Dog, Wild animals kept in captivity etc. Here in this article we will not be able to focus on all the species and mostly will be restricted to the food producing animals.

Broiler Poultry Project

Animal husbandry and allied sector such as poultry is the backbone of Indian agriculture as this sector provides food and nutritional security and creates job opportunity for two-thirds of the population. Indian poultry sector is considered as the major game changer with an overall growth of about 7-8% per annum (0.7% in National GDP). Among various agriculture and allied farming, poultry farming is one of the most efficient components of the farmer's economy as it provides eggs, meat, feathers and manures with small capital investment and fewer work forces.

This sector has emerged as the most organized sector in animal production, which is worth rupees two lakh crore. The growth is 6-8% in layers and 10-12% in broilers per year against the growth of agriculture as a whole which is around 2.5%. The Indian poultry market, consisting of broilers and eggs was worth INR 1,749.5 Billion in 2021. The market is further projected to reach INR 3,775 Billion by 2023. This transformation has involved a sizeable investment in breeding, hatching, rearing and processing activities such as slaughtering, transport, automation, products making etc. As per the reports of Indian Poultry Industry, the annual production of table eggs has gone up to 84 billion from few millions and the poultry meat production has gone up to 4.2 MMT from nowhere. However, the per capita consumption of 80 eggs and 5.2 kg of chicken is much lesser than the recommendation of the Nutritional Advisory Committee, ICMR i.e. 180 eggs and 10.8 kg poultry meat per annum, which means that the Indian poultry market is laden with opportunities. Adult population in most developed countries consume over 240 eggs and 20 kg of chicken per annum.

In the last 4 decades, poultry farming in India has been transformed from backyard activity to major

commercial operation, providing main income due to major commercial activity. India has emerged as a self-reliant, technology driven country with the capability to produce every essential input for successful poultry farming including indigenous genetic resource and breeding, world class poultry vaccines and medicines, specific, pathogen free eggs (SPF), farms and hatchery automation systems, pelleted feed, egg processing, poultry processing, nationwide network of disease diagnostic laboratories and facilities for entrepreneurial development and training in both private and public sectors. Indian poultry industry has been a major contributor to the food-processing sector in the country. Changing food habits, rising income of the middle class Indian, presence of private players, rising market demand of the Indian poultry produce in the export market are some of the contributing factors to the growth of the industry. India has 1.3 billion people and the number is growing every year. The focus is on "Development" meaning Good Food, Better Health & Living conditions to everyone. People spend more money on food when they earn more. Healthy food at attractive price will be the issue in focus. Eggs and chicken are accepted by all communities and are available at the most reasonable prices. It is pertinent to mention here that the requirement of protein, that too high quality protein is 1 g/kg body weight, but right now if we see the total amount of animal and plant protein produced in our country, it doesn't even meet 0.3 g/kg body weight requirement. Hence under such a situation, it is wise at all levels, policy makers, press, universities to work towards making better quality food available for the citizens so that it can make our nation strong and efficient.

1. All vaccinations should be done in consultation with the experts.
2. Time schedule for IBD varies with the occurrence of the disease in the area. So, proper timing of vaccination should be fixed in consultation with the local Veterinarian.

Monsoon Menace and Remedies in Poultry

The weather agency said the upcoming monsoon was expected to be “healthy normal” to the tune of 98 percent (with an error margin of +/- 5 percent) of the long period average(LPA) of 880.6mm of rainfall for the fourth month period June to September. After severe summer condition ,the monsoon season in tropical and subtropical countries, can bring severe monsoon disease thereby creating more of managerial disease. Poultry production is adversely affected by high ambient temperature and humidity. As rainy season approaches there is increase in relative humidity and a reduction in temperature. The change of humidity requires due consideration and appropriate measure for poultry to withstand seasonal fluctuation. Major consequences of unhygienic environment leads to gut health issues which is greatly influencing nutrient utilisation and growth of the birds.

For maintaining gut integrity we need to consider-

- a) Effective treatment of any gut disorder with non antibiotic growth promoter (Haloquinol 60%) or Antibiotics.
- b) Maintain normal gut health through proper healthy nutrition and disease free environment.

Above all it has invariably observed challenges to poultry farmers with the arrival of monsoon like-

- 1) Poor litter condition - Wet litter condition may arise due to seepage from the roof , overcrowding, diarrhoea and excessive salt in diets.
- 2) High level of Ammonia concentration- In many cases it has been observed that poultry sheds

are closed by curtains resulting in lack of poor ventilation and increased concentration of ammonia in deep litter shed specially.

- 3) Increase Toxicity problem – Feed and litter getting wet and damp in rainy season which leads to Aflatoxicosis, brooders pneumonia and resulting heavy mortality.

- 4) Higher respiratory distress- As there is fluctuation in the level of water and drinking of contaminated and unclean water aggravate higher intensity of respiratory problems to birds. Disease challenges like Coccidiosis, E coli outbreak due to unclean or contaminated water intake

Remedies for ill effects of Monsoon-

- 1) Always raised Floor of the poultry shed is preferred. In regions like North East, Kerela, West Bengal where rain intensity is high , the floor should be raised with roof overhang .
- 2) Food grains, feed ingredients and additives has to be stored properly and in sufficient quantity for the rainy season. Prevent the feed ingredients from getting wet in rain and always care should be taken to store bags one foot away from side walls.
- 3) In broiler (deep litter shed) need to have thick padding and make it dry. Litter should be raked frequently to keep it dry. Storage of litter materials in rainy season is important to avoid risk of shortage.
- 4) Before arrival of rainy season poultry shed to be repair. Curtains should be easily regulated depending on the rain intensity and always need to be raised for cross ventilation

- 5) There is always a big concern for fly menace during rainy season because of their high population. Fly always act as vector for many parasitic, bacterial and viral infection. Larvicidal and adulticides should be used to control fly population. Insect electrocutors will help in reducing fly burdens.
- 6) All vaccination as per schedule need to be followed in Broiler, Layer and Breeder.
- 7) Preferring non antibiotic growth promoter (Bhuquinol 60%) in regular basis during rainy season will help in reduction of bacterial, protozoal and fungal infection Halquinol is a quinolone but its mechanism of action is different from quinolones. It is an antimicrobial, antifungal, and antiprotozoal substance. Halquinol has a mechanism to slow peristalsis in the gut, thus helping to increase the absorption of nutrient from the gut.
- 8) Regular use of Anti stress drugs (BEATZ SE powder) in drinking water is helpful during rainy seasons.

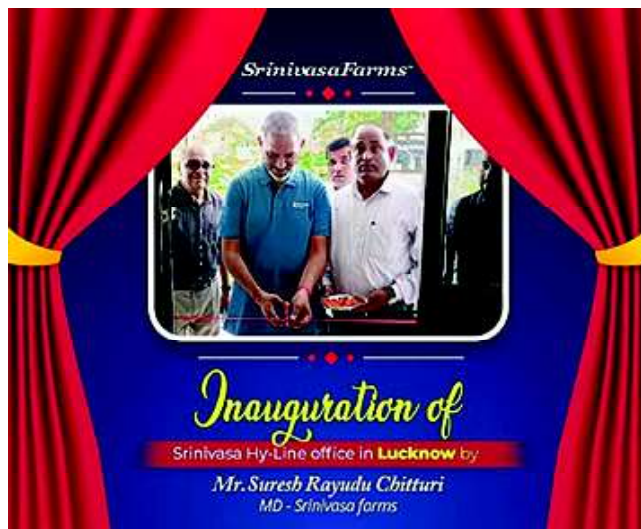

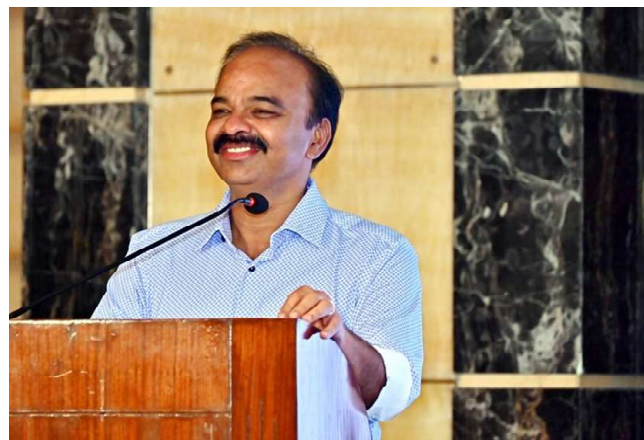

4. A lternatively in place of Guwahati other places like Tezpur, Dibrugarh or Jorhat may be considered for organising such Expo in future.

Science, Khanapara at Maniram Dewan Trade Center, Guwahati. The Equipment manufacturers, Chicks suppliers, Egg suppliers, Machineries manufacturers, Banks, Feed manufacturers and local traders and dealers have shown it. Farmers from all over the North East visted the exhibition. Though footfall was less compared to the other part of the country, whoever visited were the solid farmers. The reaction of the farmers were: “Nice”. The small women farmers found it so interesting that they are now putting pressure on family members to adopt mechanization in farms, going the local consultants for preparation of small projects, banks are getting request for loans. The expecting layer farmers could see the equipments on site, got contact of the manufacturers and suppliers and the result is layer farm proposals in pipeline. As far as I know, more than 34 layer farm proposals may come to the bank this year, I myself have prepared 4 of them, some are in contact with me. This is a good sign. Equipment manufacturers got the best response followed by the layer chicks suppliers. People who visited and also those who could not are now waiting for the next “Poultry Expo”.

Speaking on the occasion Dr. Niranjana Kalita, Director of Research (Veterinary), Assam Agricultural University, Khanapara said that it gives him immense pleasure to greet the august gathering from all parts of the country to attend the India Poultry Expo 2022 being held at Maniram Dewan Trade Centre in the fond memory of Late Dr Ajit

Kumar Bhagowati. He said that it has reminded him about the first expo which was held in the year 2019 in association with Veterinary College and All Assam Poultry Farmers and Traders Association. During that period, late Dr Bhagowati had contributed lot physically, financially and technically. Looking at Mrs Bhagowati, he said that Late Dr Bhagowati's memories will be remembered in future. Appreciating the efforts of Tezasvi Events, Hyderabad, All Assam Poultry Farmers and Traders Association and College of Veterinary Science, Khanapara, he said that the country stood 3rd and 5th positions respectively in egg and meat producing 850 million birds and 140 billion eggs, and consumption of 86 egg per capita along with 5.5kg meat approximately in the country. While per capita consumption in this area is very low, there is lot of scope for expansion. He said that the state is importing 42 lakh eggs per day incurring an expenditure of 500 crores. To overcome this deficiency such exhibitions will help lot in promoting production

Not taking much time, he wanted to give a brief introduction on PFI which is nonprofit organization with 1500 members that include poultry farmers, equipment manufacturers, breeders, feed companies, pharma companies and other allied sectors. Main purpose of PFI, he said is to work towards uplifting and benefitting the farmers whether relating to govt. or non govt. sectors. Narrating the achievements of PFI, he said it has solved the banning cages issue, the crisis of Soya imports and imports of vaccine during the crisis of bird flu and also took initiative to manufacture the vaccine indigenously by Indian Scientists which will soon be released in the market within two to three months. This way he said the PFI is working for the common cause of farmers and appealed the audience to strengthen PFI by joining as members and further invited one and all to attend the Annual General Meeting being conducted on 22nd Dec 2022





at Chandigarh to find out more on what PFI is aiming to achieve. Wishing everyone all the best, he concluded his speech saying Jai Hind and Jai Bharat.

Mr Madan Mohan Maity, General Secretary, West Bengal Poultry Federation and Secretary, Eastern India Poultry Development forum consisting of 14 states, congratulated All Assam Poultry Farmers and Traders Association, College of Veterinary Science, Khanapara and Tejasvi Publications for organizing India Poultry Expo 2022 at Guwahati in a good manner. He said that the forum is brain child of Hon'ble Late Dr Ajit Kumar Bhagowati who he is an eye opener of Poultry Association in Eastern India. He said his forum conveys best wishes to Mrs Bhagowati, her son and daughters. He said that poultry is nothing but a converting industry of the non edible human food to edible human food. The product of agriculture which is not in use of human is being used in the poultry and producing chicken and eggs for human consumption. He said



that it is the only sector which records 10% growth every year all over the country. But unfortunately all the associations of the country are not giving the remunerative price to farmers. After Covid, the farmers faced a deep crisis in shortfall of poultry feeds and very low price for their products. The main reason for this, he said that the non agricultural growth is 2% or near by the 2%. Referring to the Professor, according to ICMR recommendations of consuming 180 eggs, we are consuming near about 86 to 90. Unfortunately he said that our consumer is ready for paying Rs.10/- for a cup of tea but not willing to give Rs.10/- per egg and giving only Rs.5/- per egg. It should be changed at this type of platform or at this type of fair he said. The showcase of poultry and knowledge sharing to the farmers, what is our mode of poultry and what is the development of poultry -he questioned. In eastern part of India, the consumption of eggs per day is between 7.5 to 8 plus crores whereas we are producing only 4 crores and the deficit he said





is more than 50%. The need of more production to serve the nutritional value products to people from child to old age persons is the need of the hour. For this all associations and Govts should come together and increase the poultry related agricultural products to increase the poultry production in order to meet the demand. If the poultry related agricultural products and bi - products increased, more employment will be generated in both the sectors. He said three points are essential for the growth which are creating proper consumer awareness, advertisement, deeper in propaganda, showcase products just like in this poultry expo thus increase the production. Secondly, introduce more technological updates and technology lab to farm houses for the development and improvisation of least cost production by the help of doctors, veterinarians and scientists. Thirdly and most importantly we need to boost our agriculture in poultry related crops for the development of the poultry sector. With these three ways we can save the poultry sector as well as agricultural farmers.



He requested all governments to boost the agricultural products to produce more chicken and eggs to meet the country's demand. For this, he has an example of his own state where in 2012 they had a 4.5 million m.ton of main productions which has now increased to 2.5 billion m.ton of main productions. He said that Poultry Federation in West Bengal appraises the state govt. about the need of increasing agricultural products thus will reach the production of 5 billion m.ton in four years. If all governments boost the poultry related agricultural products, the employment will boost, the poultry production will increase and the country will overcome with the shortage of eggs and chicken. Finally he thanked all the farmers, state govt. of Assam, Department of Animal Husbandry and the Chairman, ALPCO.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr Shiv Shankar, Tezasvi Events, felt extremely honoured and proud to be part of North East India in organizing India Poultry Expo 2022 in Guwahati, Assam. He also thanked





one and all coming from different parts of the country to become part of the expo. He said that this expo is a unique effort to bring all the diligent stake holders on a single platform where one can get exposure to new developments and technologies, exchange ideas and share practical knowledge towards upliftment of poultry sector especially farmers. He continued stating this platform provided by the expo will surely contribute towards prospects in increasing the production of chicken meat and eggs. While ICMR recommendations per capita consumption of meat and egg is 10.8kg and 180 respectively, the actual consumption is 3.5kg meat and around 86 eggs in various parts of the country. However, in Assam it is 1 kg meat and 15 eggs which are very low. Hence there is an ample scope of increasing the meat and egg production and appealed all stake holders of the industry to take advantage of this platform and encourage the farmers to increase production in both the sectors. The increase in meat and egg production will help the state to overcome from malnutrition of children. He further said owing to the inherent advantages of poultry farming and relatively cheaper source of high quality protein, the industry has record annual growth of 16-18% in this region. As such, the north east region is the most crucial region of India in terms of geography along with natural resources and appealed all to utilize them to increase the production of poultry. He concluded saying sky is the limit for expansion of poultry sector in the North East and is hopeful to witness significant growth in coming years.



In the afternoon, part of the technical seminar was conducted and closed the first day's session at 6.00 PM.

The second day began with the remaining technical session. An egg eating competition at National Egg Coordination Committee's Stalls and the visitors took part with anxiety and enthusiasm. The announcer declared 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes to the winners. The day was ended at 6.00 P.M.

The day three was begun as usual at 10.00 A.M and continued till 6.00 P.M. The organisers announced best three prizes to the exhibitors. The Skylark Feeds Private Limited, Jind, Haryana won the first prize, Intas Pharmaceuticals Limited, Ahmedabad, and AutoTex Private Limited, Coimbatore jointly won the second prize and Aditi Enterprises, Guwahati, won the third prize. The special mementos of Guwahati (Xorai) were presented to them at the closing ceremony.

A traditional dance of Guwahati culture was arranged and the same was attracted one and all and they have appreciated the organizers for arranging such nice programme. The stalwarts of the region felt that this type of expo should be organised every year at par with international levels as the growth of poultry in North East part of India is growing at a rapid level and need such expo for the betterment of the farmers of the region. The organizers assured to do so and declared its next expo in September/ October 2023. The expo ended with a satisfactory note.







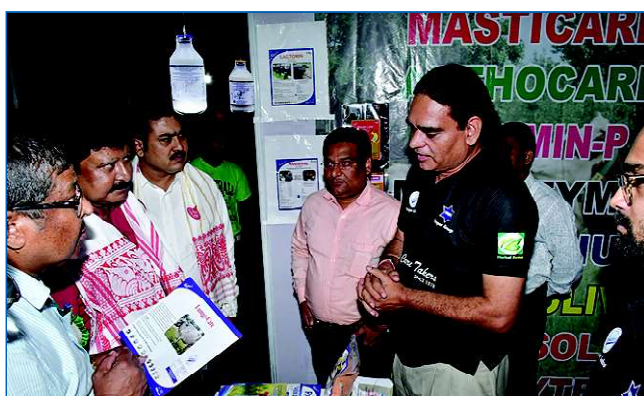

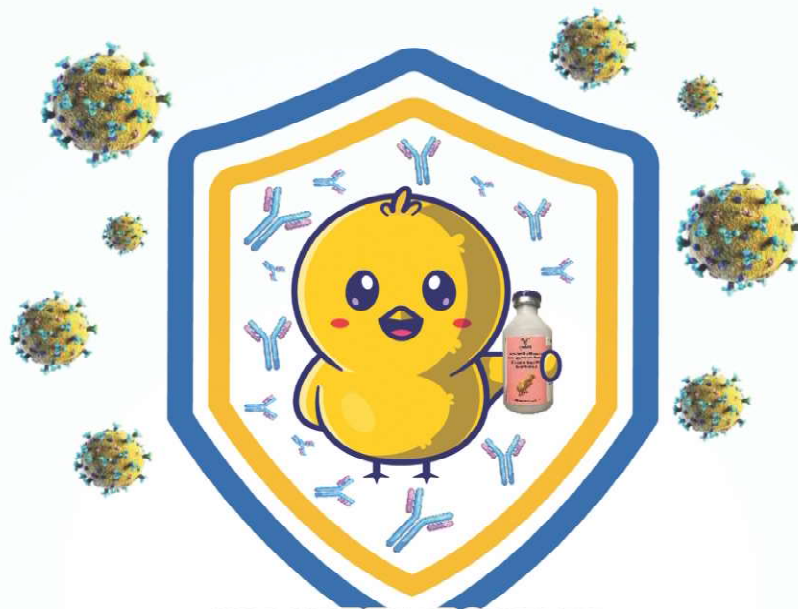
